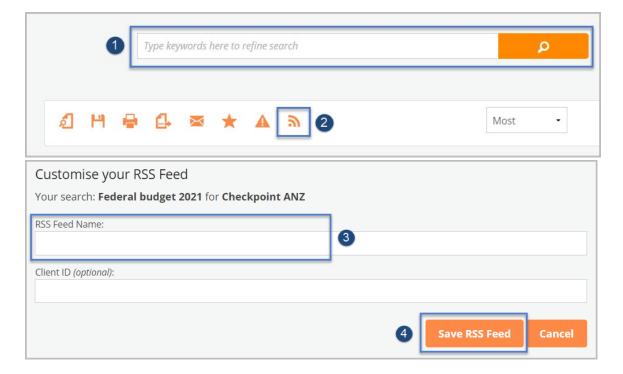
Checkpoint enables alerts to be setup to send notifications when new documents are added to Checkpoint. You can define the areas to be notified, when and how you receive the alerts.

Creating and Subscribing to an RSS feed

RSS (Really Simple Syndication) feeds allow you to view new online content, as soon as it's added, without having to log on to the service. To create, view and manage News Feeds, you need to first obtain news reader software or use browser software with built-in news reader software. Examples of these include Internet Explorer, Firefox, and Safari. These browsers can be used to manage your RSS feeds in the same way that you manage bookmarks. The examples in this guide use Internet Explorer as the browser.

- 1. Run a search.
- 2. Click the RSS Feed icon from the white toolbar
- 3. Enter an RSS feed name and
- 4. Click the Save RSS Feed button



- 5. From the RSS Feeds page, you will see the RSS Feed created and saved
- 6. Copy the link and use within your preferred RSS Feed reader.
