


1) To create your own version of a Matter Map, click 'Copy and edit map' in the top left-hand corner.



- 2) Click on the **pencil icon** to rename or edit the description of the Map.
- 3) Click on the 3 dots next to a task or phase to edit or delete. You can edit the name, description and resources listed for each phase or task. You can add resources from within Practical Law Global, Practical Law Australia or any other website by adding the URL.
- 4) Click on the + icon to add new phases and tasks.
- 5) Click on the white oval to assign a colour code to any task.





6) Once you have completed your customisation, you can use the delivery options at the top right of the screen to email, print or download. You can also create a deep link to the matter map for ease of sharing.



7) Customised Maps will be automatically saved to My Custom Maps which is accessible via the **Interactive**Matter Maps landing page, under the Custom Maps tab.
